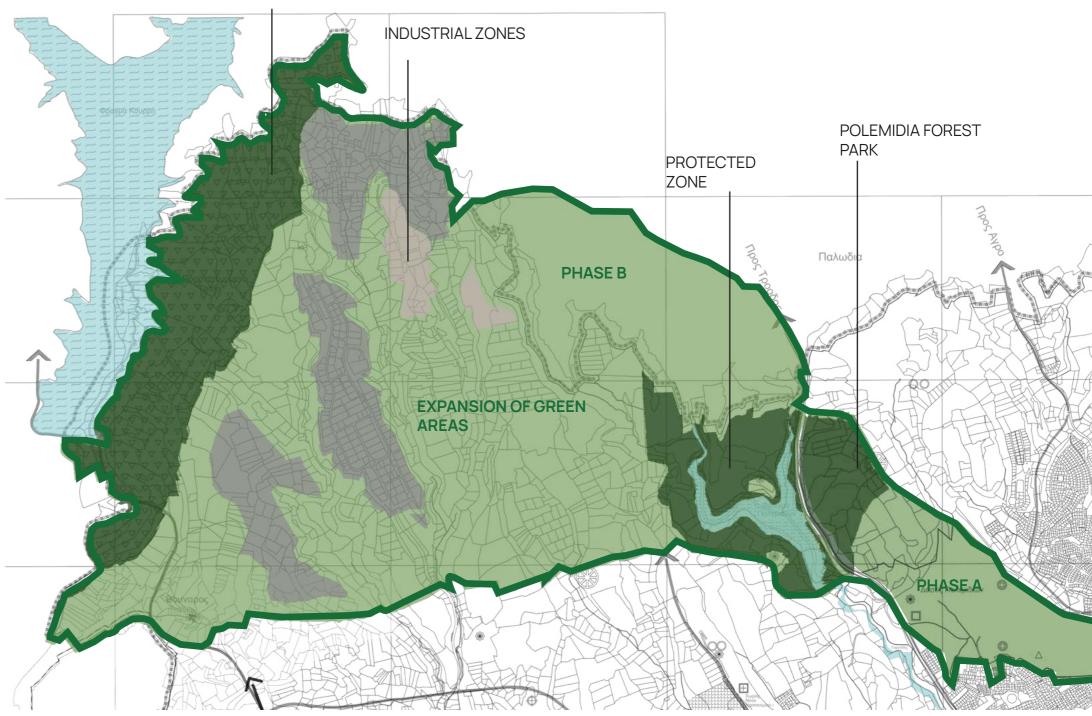


Metropolitan Park

- promoting alternative means of public transport to decrease vehicles and traffic in the city center

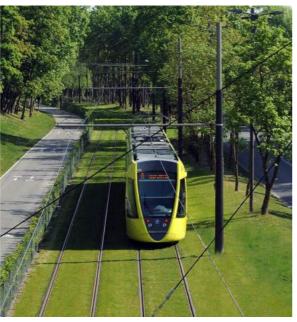


Suggested peripheral parking areas - New Port Area

- a very discrete intervention to the public realm that can be easily integrated with the existing environment

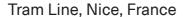




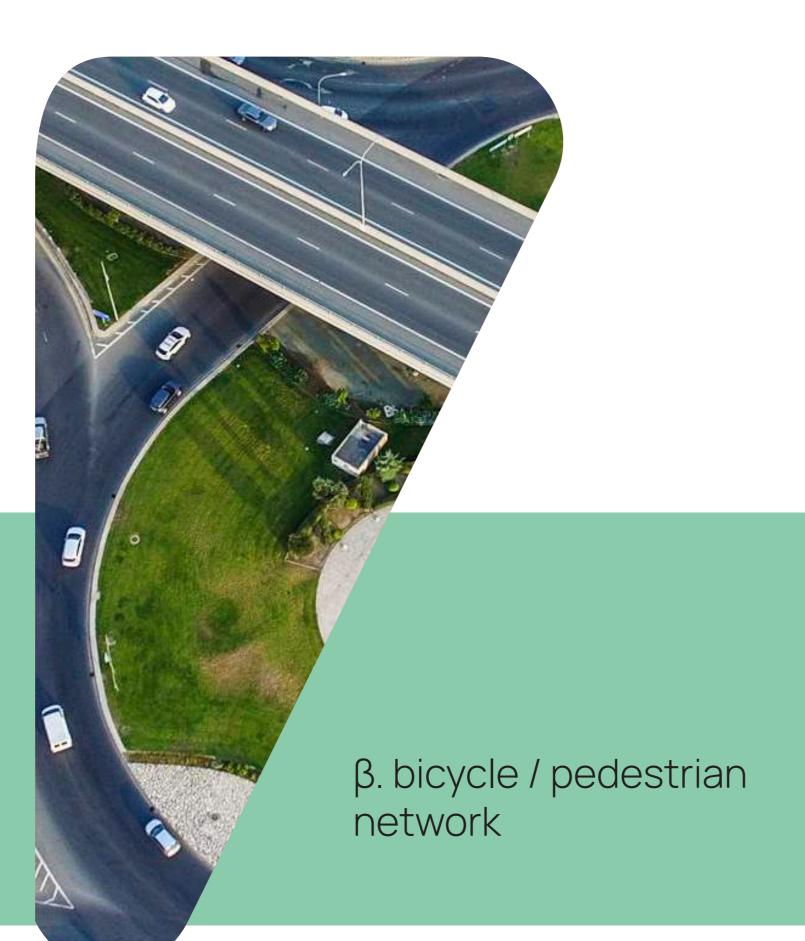

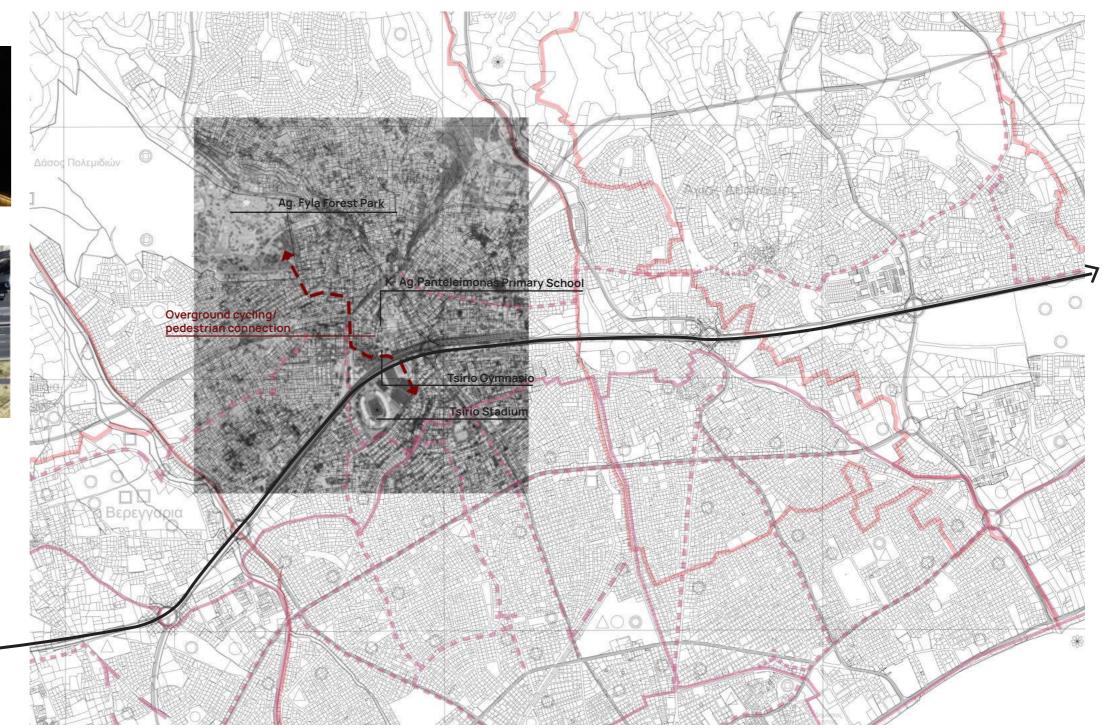

- overground connection at Tsirio Stadium (pedestrian/ bike bridge) for easier and safer circulation in the city



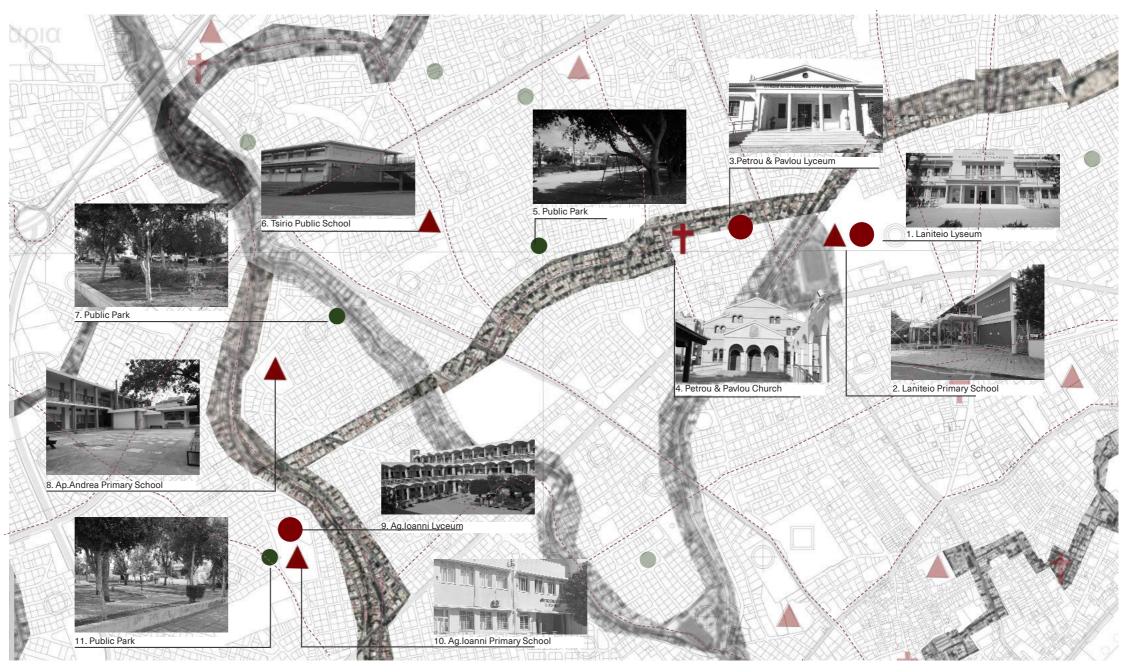

lively center 24 hours a day

- -cultural center
- -incentives to increase entrepreneurship and encourage the return of permanent residents
- development of the second nucleus of the Cyprus University of Technology
- 50% of city center is uninhabited - creating policies for old building reuse, live center 24 hours a day, with compatible uses
- -enhancing public spaces with pedestrianized streets, more green and zero pollutants eventually
